A marina call by a vessel shall be entered by the Harbour Master or Marina Steward in the log book. Departure from the Marina shall be permitted once services have been paid for and the relevant permission has been received from the Harbour Master or the person acting as his/her deputy.

The Capten of the vessel must present the vessel's name, registration number, country of registration and the number of people on board together with the Captains personal- and contact details to the Harbor administration.

Works inside and on the deck of moored vessels (execution of works that generate noise and rubbish; welding and works involving fire; outboard works; launch of boats and rafts; ballast water pumping; tank cleaning, repair of propulsion (main engine)):

Large scale repair- and paintwork not to be done in the Harbor. Noise or waste-producing repairworks on a vessel must be coordinated with the harbor's administration. Lifting the vessel out of the water for repairworks or for any other necessities, must be coordinated with the harbor's capten (or person apponted by him) before doing so.

3. Vessel traffic rules:**Vessel traffic in the port's water area (shifting, maneuvering):**

<p>3.1. Vessels' speed in the entire harbor area must not exceed 3 knots and must allow safe navigation.</p> <p>3.1.1. Relocation of the vessels within the Harbor should only be done with a permission from the Harbor's Captain or a steward.</p> <p>3.1.2. When entering and exiting the Harbor, the advantage is on departing ships.</p> <p>3.2. With a wind speed of 12 m/sec and a wave lenght of 1 m, vessel traffic in the Harbor's aquatory is prohibited.</p> <p>3.3. Mooring space will be allocated by the Harbor's capten or a steward.</p> <p>3.3.1. Good Seafarer's practice must be followed when Mooring.</p> <p>3.3.2. Mooring must not endanger other vessels or the harbor.</p> <p>3.3.3. Mooring ends must be fastened and fenders placed in a way, that quarantees a safe mooring to all vessels in any weather condition.</p> <p>3.3.4. A vessel's Captain is obliged to add more fenders or mooring ends if instructed to do so by the Harbor's Captain or the Steward.</p>

Fire safety on board of a vessel is the responsibility of the Captain of that Vessel.</p> <p>7.3. Fire hazardous works on the vessel must be coordinated with the Harbor's Captain.</p> <p>7.4. A Fire in the Harbor must be reported immediately to the Harbor's administration and to Emergency Services by phoning 112.</p> <p>7.5. In the event of the Fire in the Harbor or on a Mooring vessel, all vessels in the Harbor must ready their Rescue- and Fire Extinguishing Equipment and their main engine (if applicable) to assist in the fire extinguishing process or to evacuate if needed.</p>
